THE FOLLOWING RESTICTIONS APPLY TO ALL LOGGING COMPANIES
WORKING IN COVINGTON COUNTY

*****PERMITS MUST BE OBTAINED BEFORE TIMBER OPERATIONS BEGIN*****

1. Keep ditches clean of tree and limb debris during operation.
2. Do not allow any limbs to overhang into the road right of way as a result of timber operations.
3. Remove all excessive dirt and/or mud from roadway.
4. Set up "CAUTION LOGGING OPERATION AHEAD" signs 500 feet from an intersection of the entry and exiting of log trucks onto roadway.
5. NO loading in the road or and operation on the shoulder of the roadway.
6. The Supervisor of the district where operations occur must sign the permit BEFORE operations begin.
7. Timber companies will be responsible for any damage to the roadway which is a direct cause from timber operations. Timber companies may be billed for any repairs to the roadway by the county if the timber company refuses to or fails to make the repairs in a reasonable time period. Any repairs made by the timber company must be approved by the County Supervisor.
